General:

- **Court Booking:** An online court booking system operates for adult members. Details (including login) will be provided to you with your membership. A court may be booked between 09:00 and 21:00. Adult members may book one month ahead; team captains and club coaches can book further ahead.
- **Guest Fees**: This is a members' club. Guests may play with a member for a fee of £3 per session for adults, £2 for children (up to 6 times a year) payable to the club directly either by bank transfer to Dormansland Tennis Club (A/C 30486701, sort code 20-23-97) or by cash/cheque placed in an envelope and dropped through the letterbox of The Crossways, 1 High Street, Dormansland RH7 6PU (marked with your name, payment purpose, date and amount).
- **Floodlights**: Available at a cost of £2 for each 30 minutes per court, payable to the club directly either by bank transfer to Dormansland Tennis Club (A/C 30486701, sort code 20-23-97) or by cash/cheque placed in an envelope and dropped through the letterbox of The Crossways, 1 High Street, Dormansland RH7 6PU (marked with your name, payment purpose, date and amount).

Allocated court times:

Playing Rules:

- Proper tennis clothing and shoes (non-marking soles) must be worn at all times while playing.
- Junior members are strictly forbidden access to the clubhouse without adult supervision.
- Where there is no court booking, if a court is in use by adults and adult members are waiting to play, members should revert to playing a short set, or not exceed playing time by more than 30 minutes.
- Except for official junior coaching, adult members have priority on use of the courts and juniors must vacate the courts when requested. However, it is hoped that adult members will be reasonable on this point, and that juniors are allowed to complete the game or continue playing for a further 10-15 minutes.
- Club matches and tournaments take priority over normal play.
- Juniors may only use the floodlights under the supervision of an adult.
- No loud music, dogs, bikes, skateboards or balls etc.

Other:

- Bins: Bins are provided on the courts and in the clubhouse for the convenience of members. On the courts, please ensure that you only put recyclable items in the (recycling) green bins (the green ones); the grey bins are for all other general rubbish. Note that, in Tandridge, drinks cups are recyclable. Please also ensure that all containers are completely emptied of liquids before being placed in any bin.
- Padlocks: The padlock codes are provided to members whenever they are changed.
 We are aware that people obtain the top court code by looking at the padlock when
 members are playing. Please, when on court, always close the top court padlock and
 scramble the numbers (leaving the padlock hanging on its chain) so the code cannot be
 obtained by anyone looking at the lock.
